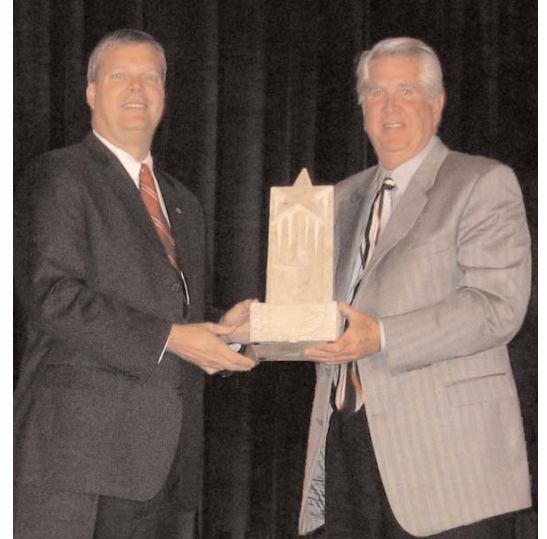
## Bob Moore Construction Wins 2005 AGC General Contractor of the Year Award
