Cinemark Opens First Movie Theater in Mansfield, Texas

Cinemark USA is a leading motion picture exhibitor with 302 theaters and 3,254 screens in 33 U.S. States and 13 countries. Their newest theater is a stunning 12-screen facility in Mansfield, Texas.

The new theater is Cinemark's 18th in Dallas / Fort Worth and the first ever in the City of Mansfield.

The 42,265 SF theater seats 2,010 patrons. The exterior features a dramatic, full-height stone veneer, the first time this has been used on a

Cinemark theater. All 12 wall-to-wall screens employ top quality Christie projectors, Dolby Digital sound and tiered stadium-style seating.

"It turned out great," said Chris Cline, Project Manager for Cinemark USA. "We're very happy with the work Bob Moore Construction did. The superintendents and everyone involved were very professional and the quality is just outstanding."

Miller Electric Moves to Seefried Properties' Riverpark 300

Miller Electric, a leading manufacturer of arc welding equipment, is a subsidiary of Illinois Tool Works (NYSE:ITW).

When Miller wanted to consolidate its Houston and Dallas facilities into one location, they chose a 55,000 SF space in Seefried Properties' Riverpark 300 building in Fort Worth, Texas. Bob Moore Construction was the General Contractor, Teague Nall & Perkins in Fort Worth performed civil duties and Realacorp America in Atlanta, Georgia managed structural and A/E design.

Riverpark 300 can support up to four tenants with 300,000 SF of space, 88 cross-dock loading doors and a 32' clear height ceiling. Miller Electric's space includes a large warehouse and distribution area with ceiling-high racking. It also provides space for offices and an elaborate facility where 450 distribu-

tors each year will receive classroom and hands-on training.

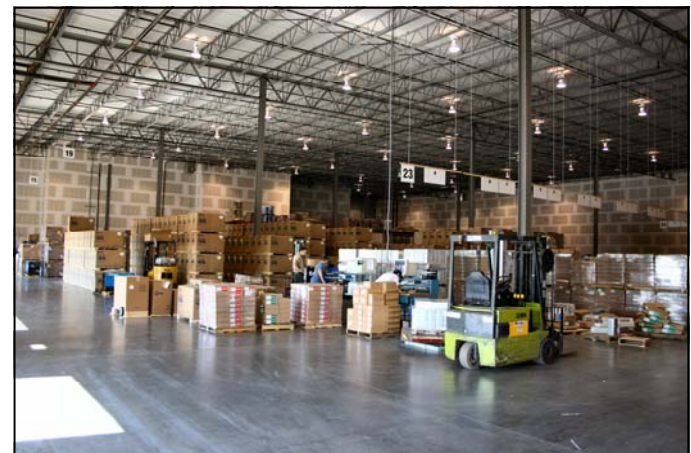
